<p>God gave four commands to Adam. He failed two of them. So do many men today. He toiled at his job, but failed to protect his family.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Toil in the Garden 2. Guard the Garden 3. Eat of every tree 4. Do not eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. <p>God gave Adam and Eve six further commands:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Be fruitful 6. Multiply 7. Replenish the earth 8. Subdue it 9. Have dominion 10. Eat seed bearing fruit <p>Adam had three goals. First, to maintain a daily walk with God. Second, to guard his treasures. Third, to teach God's commands. The wife was to help him fulfill these three goals so their children would be mighty upon the earth as explained in Psalm 112.</p>	<p>God gave Israel a law system designed to make them successful and to foreshadow the coming of Christ and His perfect law. They disobeyed it.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Thou shalt have no other gods before me. 2. Thou shalt not make any graven images. 3. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain. 4. Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy. 5. Honor thy father and thy mother. 6. Thou shalt not kill. 7. Thou shalt not commit adultery. 8. Thou shalt not steal. 9. Thou shalt not bear false witness against they neighbor. 10. Thou shalt not covet. <p>There is a wealth of practical wisdom in this law system. Those who glean it will be healthier, wealthier and wiser than any other nation. It was a covenant relationship between God and His chosen people.</p>	<p>Jesus received commands from His Heavenly Father that taught the true nature of holiness. Notice how He refined and upgraded the law to Israel.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ye have heard thou shalt not kill, but I say unto you, whosoever is angry. 2. Ye have heard thou shalt not commit adultery, but I say unto you whosoever looks on a woman to lust after her 3. Ye have heard thou shalt not foreswear thyself. Let your yes be yes and no be no. 4. Ye have heard, an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth, but I say unto you, bless those that curse you. 5. Honor father, mother 6. Beware of covetousness <p>Plus 43 more...</p> <p>Jesus received and taught about 49 commands and explained that through them He would reveal Himself (John 14:21). He did not send out His disciples to teach the ten commandments, but rather "all things that I have commanded you."</p>
